Introduction

Joondalup Senior School Campus (Joondalup Campus) caters for year 11 & 12 students who wish to move directly into apprenticeships and employment as they complete high school. The students are enrolled at Wanneroo Secondary College however they maintain a close connection with their current school. They attend classes at the Joondalup Campus situated at 2 Onslow Place Joondalup.

This Prospectus has been prepared for your information and to assist you to develop an understanding of the policies, philosophies, practices and benefits of the Joondalup Campus.

The staff and students at the Joondalup Campus are committed to high standards of work, behaviour and working relationships.

The Joondalup Campus provides a work-like environment where staff and students take on more of an employer-employee relationship. We endeavour to treat every student as a young adult and, as such, some rules and policies differ slightly from those at the students' home campus. Of course we expect these privileges to be accepted with maturity and a sense of responsibility by every student.

The Joondalup Campus is a fresh start. School issues from the past can be forgotten. How students choose to present themselves from now on is what matters, not the past. Staff and students begin each day with a clean slate.

The Joondalup Campus offers a great working environment in an excellent facility with all the necessary resources readily available. Small class sizes, 12 to 18 students per class, mean that students have greater access to more resources, including teacher time. As there are only 6 classes with a total of around 90 students at the campus, there are fewer distractions'; this gives students the time to focus on themselves and where they want to be in the future.

At the Joondalup Campus the teachers move from class to class. Students work in the same room and with the same group of people for each lesson, no matter what the subject. Each student has their own work station and computer.

The days are organised differently at Joondalup Campus, to allow the completion of four courses in three days. This allows for release into the workforce and alternate training facilities on Thursday and Friday.

Joondalup Campus's greatest asset is the positive working relationships which develop between team members, staff and students. Throughout our working lives we come in contact with many different types of people. We may not like all of them but nonetheless we must work together effectively in a courteous and respectful way.











Although our campus is situated in Joondalup, you are still very much a part of your Hone School or Wanneroo Secondary College. As such, all students are entitled to be involved in whole school events such as sports days, photo days, graduation ceremonies, school ball etc.

The Joondalup Campus Manager, (Chris Leggett), is in regular contact with the your *Home School* regarding your progress. Wanneroo SC will manage aspects such as staffing, budgeting, reporting procedures, enrolments and work place learning.

GOALS, VALUES AND BELIEFS

Our goals at the Joondalup Campus are simple, academic and social.

Academic:

- 1. Achieve a Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE) and a Western Australian Statement of Student Achievement (WASSA) that reflects each student's talents and abilities.
- 2. To be work ready and/or able to gain entry to TAFE or a portfolio entry into university.

Social:

Our values and beliefs require that we do our very best to achieve our potential in all areas as we strive to earn the trust and respect of each other. This can be accomplished with the commitment of every team member to:-

- ☐ Treat each team member with respect; everyone has the right to feel valued and respected.
- ☐ Treat each team member fairly.

- ☐ Quickly and effectively resolve conflicts in a way that is respectful of all team members.
- ☐ Have open communication between all team members to ensure a positive work environment with a high work output.

THE ACADEMIC PROGRAM

Students enrolled in the program should achieve WACE and also complete VET Certificates that would allow them to access TAFE courses upon their exit from secondary school.

The students spend three days a week at school (Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday), one day at TAFE and one day at a work placement. In year 12 most students are

enrolled into a traineeship in place of the work experience component.

The subjects studied are:-

- General English or Foundation English
- Essential Mathematics or Foundation Mathematics
- Health Studies or Foundation Health Studies
- Certificate II in Business
- Workplace Learning, Endorsed Program

In addition the students will complete additional VET certificates up to Certificate IV in years 11 & 12.

ENROLMENT PROCEDURES

 Complete the Application for Enrolment, Joondalup Senior School Campus, and submit it to your Home School or Wanneroo Secondary SC





- 2. Your Home School will provide:-
 - A. Most recent School Report.
 - B. Printout of Behaviour Reports for the past 18 months. (SIS, SEQTA or similar).
 - C. OLNA results to assist the campus to develop support plans.
 - D. Any information that would assist WSC to provide the appropriate level of support to the student.
- An interview for admittance to the program will be held for all applicants at the Joondalup Campus.
 Students will be invited to attend with a parent.
 The Interview Panel will be composed from:-
 - A. Manager of Joondalup Campus
 - B. Student representative
 - C. Student Services Manager from the students current school
- Successful applicants will be advised and the student will be enrolled at Wanneroo SC, Joondalup Campus.

However the student will be able to:-

- A. Represent their *Home School* or Wanneroo SC in sport, cheer leading etc.
- B. Attend the school ball at either their Home School or Wanneroo SC.
- C. Return to their Home School if the student does not wish to remain at the Joondalup Campus (after a reasonable trial)
